As soon as they enter the state of youth, the evil impressions nip them in the bud. I don't want to oppose anybody; but I feel grieved over seeing the destruction of humanity. This assault has its origin in western countries. Instead of opposing it; we'll just give it a new direction; so that this does the welfare of foreign people as well. You do celebrate the day of love by saying, '*Matridevo Bhava; Pitridevo Bhava.*' – 'Regard your mother as a god; regard your father as a god.'

'Parents' Worship Day' - The Turning Point for the Humanity

All people should respect their parents. I want to propagate 'Parents' Worship Day' widely in India and abroad. Children should greet, respect and worship their parents on this day; and parents should love their children. It will help develop real love.



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Passion and lust give a bad name to love. There is a big difference between love and lust. Lust is centered in the lower Chakras. It gives rise to sexual excitement; and thoughtless gratification of desires. And love is centered in the upper Chakras of human body. It makes one thoughtful; and it gives eternal joy. And it helps one behold oneself in all creatures. I don't want that people only of this country should be elevated. May the whole of humanity be saved from the attack of sexualization (of the society); and go forward on the path of self-restraint and virtue to live a healthy, happy and honorable life; may good come to the whole world; because this (broadmindedness) is what we have inherited.

According to the *Innocenti* Report Card issue No.3 at least 1.25 million teenagers become pregnant each year in the 28 OECD nations under review. Out of those, approximately half a million will seek an abortion and approximately three quarters of a million will become teenage mothers. 4,94,357 children are born to teenage mothers each year in America. Every year some 3 million American teenagers contact a sexually transmitted disease (about 1 in every 4 sexually experienced teenagers).

In one act of unprotected sex with an infected partner, a teenage woman has 1 in 100 chance of contacting HIV, 1 in 3 chance of contacting genital herpes, and 1 in 2 chance of contacting gonorrhoea. Approximately a quarter of all new cases of HIV/AIDS are diagnosed in young people under the age of 22. Today, 1 in 3 US high schools has an abstinence only policy on sex education. Since 1996 more than US-\$400 million in federal and state funds have been spent on 'Abstinence Only' campaigns in America's schools. Parents have spent longer time in this world; so they are more experienced than us. There can be no comparison of Sadguru's great experience with our petty experience. Opinion of Modern Scientists

Generally people jump to ask, 'What's the correlation between parents' worship and good performance in studies?' Those in doubt about it should study the conclusion of research work carried out in USA by Jane Kim, an attorney and immigration specialist at the Children's Hospital of Pennsylvania, and Dr. Soo Kim Abboud, a surgeon and clinical assistant professor at the University of Pennsylvania. 'How do Asian students get to the top of the class in American universities and schools?' Research carried out on this subject revealed that this was so because they respect their elders and obey their parents. They study hard and do well in school to secure a bright future. Even those who don't believe in saints and Shastras of Indian culture have to accept these teachings (of Shastras); and have to teach the western students to respect their parents to get good results.

Those who respect their parents can't spoil their character by celebrating 'Valentine's Day'. Living with self-control; they will protect their Brahmacharya (celibacy, chastity & virginity) and will develop their intellectual faculties; which will help them get good academic results.

Once at Lord Shiva's home, his both sons had a dispute as to who was the greater of the two.

Kartikeya said: "Ganapati! I am greater than you."

Ganapati said: "You may be elder to me; but greatness is determined by the virtues also."

For final decision the matter was referred to their parents Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati.

Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati said:

"Whoever would make the tour of the whole world and come back first to the starting point; had the right to be the greater."

Kartikeya flew off at once on his vehicle, the peacock to circumambulate the world. Ganapati quietly went to a secluded place. He reposed for a while to find out the solution. Then he came to Shiva-Parvati. Holding his parents' hands; he made them sit together on a high place; worshipped them with flowers and circumambulated them. He saluted them at the end of every circumambulation. This way he circumambulated the parents seven times.

Shiva and Parvati asked: "Son! Why did you circumambulate us?"

Ganapati said: "Mother is the embodiment of all pilgrimages, father is the embodiment of all deities. Hence mother and father are to be revered with all efforts." According to Vedas, circumambulating one's mother gives virtues equivalent to that of circumambulating the whole world. Hence by circumambulating you, mother; I have circumambulated the whole world seven times. Worship of father is equal to the worship of all gods; because the father is a god." Since then Ganapati became the foremost god to be worshipped. The Shiva-Purana states:

पित्रोश्च पूजनं कृत्वा प्रक्रान्तिं च करोति यः ।
तस्य वै पृथिवीजन्यफलं भवति निश्चितम् ॥

It means: 'He who worships his parents and circumambulates them, will certainly derive the fruit and merit of circumambulating the earth.'

Pujya Bapuji says: "Do celebrate Love-Day; but incorporate self-restraint and true progress in Love-Day."



Method of Parents' Worship

The person conducting the ritual of worship should slowly keep speaking the method of worship; and should keep chanting the following Mantras and Aarti (worship-ceremony with lamp & hymns of praise). Children and parents will perform the worship ceremony accordingly.

* Then make the parents sit on a high seat.

आसने स्थापिते ह्यत्र पूजार्थं भवतोरिह ।

भवन्तौ संस्थितौ तातौ पूर्यतां मे मनोरथः ॥

It means: 'O my parents! I have made this seat for you; please accept it; and fulfill my heartfelt wish.'

* The children should apply a tilak on parents' foreheads with kumkum powder. Then they should put flowers and rice on parents' heads; and make them wear flower-garlands. Then they should



circumambulate the parents seven times. This will give the children the fruit of the earth's circumambulations.

यानि कानि च पापानि जन्मान्तरकृतानि च ।
तानि सर्वाणि नश्यन्तु प्रदक्षिणपदे पदे ॥

* Then the children will duly and respectfully bow and greet the parents as per the method shown in the picture of the booklet.

अभिवादनशीलस्य नित्यं वृद्धोपसेविनः ।

चत्वारि तस्य वर्धन्ते आयुर्विद्या यशो बलम् ॥

It means: 'Whosoever habitually and respectfully greets and serves the parents and preceptors obtains an increase of four things, viz length of life, knowledge, fame, and strength.' (Manusmriti: 2.121)

* The children will do the Aarti (worship-ceremony) with lighted lamp placed in a thali (metal plate) and hymns of praise. The children will make a firm resolve to serve the parents and the preceptor beholding god in them.

दीपज्योतिः परं ब्रह्म दीपज्योतिर्जनार्दनः ।

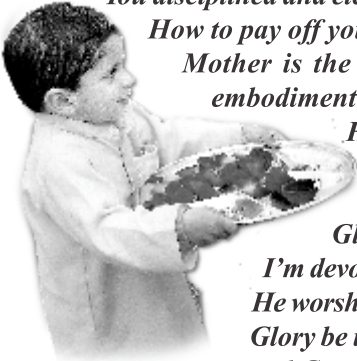
Glory be unto parents, Guru and God.

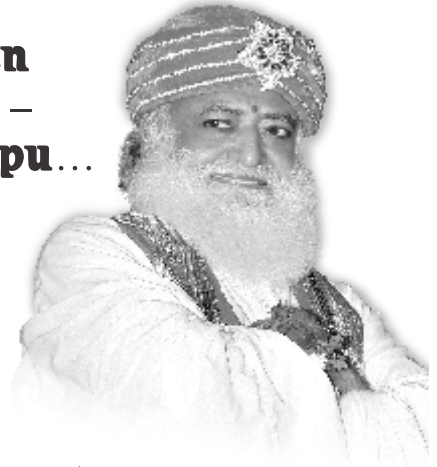

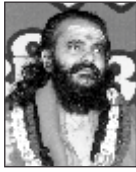
Birth & Childhood: Asumal was born on 17th April 1941 in Berani village of Sindh province of undivided India. His father, Shri Thaumal Sirumalani was a leading person in the town; and His mother Mehengibha was a deeply religious and simple-hearted woman. Looking at the divine radiance on His countenance in childhood; His family preceptor had prophesied, “This child will become a great saint, and deliver many people.” The family preceptor’s prophecy has come true. Now all know it.

Youth (Discrimination & Dispassion): Bapuji had developed discrimination and dispassion to the highest level during his childhood and youth. So; he renounced home in His young age to wander restlessly yearning for God in deep forests. Then He found His Sadguru in Swami Shri Lilashahji in the forests of Nainital, India. He attained Self-Realization at the young age of 23. Then His Guru said, ‘From today the people will know you as ‘Sant Asharamji’; and whatever spiritual divinity you have achieved; distribute it among the masses.’ The same Asumal, established in Brahman, is imparting spiritual knowledge through his teachings to philosophers, scientists, political leaders, officers, educated and uneducated male and female seekers of Truth; and giving the right direction to the perplexed human society wandering aimlessly in the jungle of life.

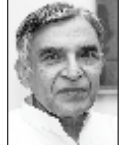

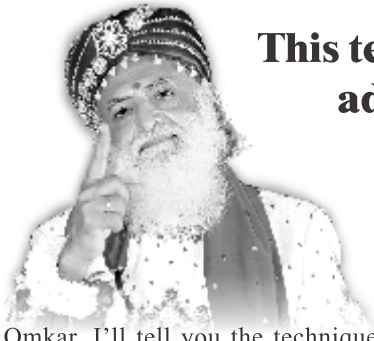

Dr. J. Morgan and other doctors say that Indian Omkar-Mantra is very effective in curing diseases. The holy scripture 'Pranavada' contains 22,000 shlokas related to Omkar. I'll tell you the technique of Omkar-Mantra japa (Mantra-Repetition). This will generate the energy to destroy sins. You will get divine joy in your heart. If children do it; they will develop memory power and excel in their exams. Then the people of the world as well as God will love them.

You must take the following solemn pledge before you start your Mantra-Japa: **'Omkar-Mantrah, Gaayatri-Chhandah; Bhagawan-Narayan-Rishih; Antrayami Parmatma-Devata; Antrayami-Prityarthe; Parmatma-Prapti Arthe Jape-Viniyogah'** (Omkar is the mantra. Its meter is Gayatri. It was originally revealed to a Rishi, Lord Narayana, its presiding deity is Antaryamin, the Supreme Self. I am chanting this Mantra for attainment of Supreme Self.)

First of all plug your index fingers into your ears, and then take a long and deep breath. The deeper and longer you inhale; more the air sacs of your lungs will open; and your immunity will increase. Hold the breath in, and chant the auspicious sacred Name of God, Omkara through your larynx. Then close your mouth and chant OM...OM...OM...O.....M and breath out, then inhale again to repeat the same process ten times. Then take your fingers out of the ears.

After doing this much; sit quietly. Then repeat Omkar in a whispering tone with movement of lips - 'Om-Om my Lord Om; blissful Lord Om, indwelling Lord Om...' Do it for two minutes. Then repeat Omkara from the heart (solarplexus) without moving tongue and lips - 'Om-Shanti... Om-Ananda... Om-Om-Om...' Then repeat from the throat. Lord Krishna had imparted this technique to His mother Yashoda. It's better if you burn incense *Gauchandana* or fragrant-bdellium (incense-stick) before doing Japa, if not then you can do it without it also. Sit on a blanket-sheet or carpet-asana; which is non-conductor of electricity. Its practice will add luster to your glory. IMPORTANCE OF EKADASHI-FAST

The primary goal of human life is Self-Realization. Only a person equipped with all these three things – physical health, mental strength and purity of intellect gets pleasures and salvation. The fasts and Vratas observed with right understanding on Ekadashi play a vital role in it. It is replete with instructions on man's all round development.

Kamada Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Chaitra): Cursed *gandharva* Lalita had become a demon. His state of a demon went away and he became a *gandharva* again by the prowess of the religious merit obtained by fasting on the Kamada Ekadashi. It saves one from the state of goblinhood and destroys the sin of killing a Brahmana.

Mohini Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Vaishakha): Dhristabuddhi was expelled from the house by his father and forsaken by his kinsmen; because he was always engaged in committing great sins, and was always attached to drinking liquor and prostitutes. He duly observed the vow of Mohini Ekadashi. His sins vanished. Then he having a divine body, and mounted Garuda and went to Vishnu's world. Fasting on this Ekadashi destroys great sins.

Nirjala Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Jyeshtha): One, who observes the vow of this Ekadashi obtains the fruit of Ekadashis that fall during the year. The fruit of all meritorious deeds like a gift, muttering of prayers, a sacrifice that is given by a man on this day becomes unending. Those who have fasted on this day, keeping awake at night, have taken along with themselves hundred (members) of their families past and future to the abode of Lord Vishnu.

Shayani (Devashayani) Ekadashi (falls on the bright half of Ashadha): This Ekadashi is very auspicious, which gives heaven and salvation. Those men who pass the four months (from the eleventh of bright half of Ashadha to the eleventh of bright half of Kartika) remaining in celibacy (observing the rules of Dharma) would reach the highest position.

Kamika Ekadashi (falls in the dark half of Shravana): Merely by hearing about it; one would obtain the fruit of (having performed) a *Vajpeya* sacrifice. His sins; who worships Lord Vishnu with Tulsi sprouts on this day, perish right from his birth. Chitrugupta is not able to know the measure of the religious merits of the man; who gives a light on this day. The dead ancestors of his, whose lamp burns in front of Vishnu, remain in heaven and are gratified with nectar.

Putrada Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Shravana): Sonless king Mahijit was blessed with a son due to the merits of this vow; who had observed the vow of this Ekadashi. He begot a son. This Ekadashi gives all desired objects.

Aja Ekadashi (falls in the dark half of Bhadrapada): Effect of some previous life's actions; king Harishchandra was deprived of his kingdom. He observed the vow of this Ekadashi. He engaged himself in a fast, keeping awake at night. By

the efficacy of Ekadashi, he got the kingdom free from any nuisance. Due to the efficacy of the vow, he was united with his wife, and lived with his son. This Ekadashi destroys all troubles and sufferings.

Padma Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Bhadrapada): There was a draught in the kingdom of king Mandhata. He along with all his subjects observed the vow of this Ekadashi. When the vow was observed, the cloud showered. Land was inundated with water and was resplendent with corn. The people got happiness. This vow destroys all sins, gives devotion to God and salvation. The man; who observes this vow; gets the fruit of all sacrifices and pilgrimages.

Indira Ekadashi (falls in the dark half of Ashvina): King Indrasen received a message from the god of death, Yama through sage Narada that his father was staying with him due to some hindrance, due to his former existence. By the power of the vow of this Ekadashi; king Indrasen's father went to heaven. By its power even a great sin perishes. It gives a (good) cause to the dead that have gone to (i.e. born in) a low stock.

Papankusha Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Ashvina): This Ekadashi removes all sins. This vow gives heaven and salvation. It gives good health of the body. This gives a beautiful wife, wealth and friends. One, who fasts on this day, keeping awake at night, would emancipate ten members on his mother's side, ten on his father's side, and ten on his wife's side.

Ramaa Ekadashi (falls in the dark half of Kartika): By the power of the religious merit of this Ekadashi, Chandrabhaga, (a queen whose weak husband had expired due to fasting on this Ekadashi and become a ruler of a divine charming city on the peak of the Mandara Mountain), enjoyed divine pleasures, of a divine form, and adorned with divine ornaments, rejoiced with her husband. This Ekadashi removes great sins and leads to the acquisition of desired objects like Chintamani (a supposed jewel granting its possessor desired objects) and Kamadhenu (a mystical cow of plenty supposed to yield whatever is requested of her).

Prabodhini Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Kartika): One, who duly observes this fast gets endless happiness; and then in the end goes to heaven.

Mokshada Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Margashirsha): The sins of him who observes vow of the Mokshada Ekadashi, perish, and after death he would obtain salvation. This vow is like the desire-yielding gem.

Putrada Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Paush): Sonless king Suketuman observed the vow of this Ekadashi according to the proper rules. A bright son was born to his queen. This is an excellent day that removes all sins.

Jaya Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Magha): Malyavan and Pushpadanti were cursed by Indra to be turned into goblins. With the efficacy of the vow of this Ekadashi their goblinhood disappeared and they obtained their celestial forms as before. Men are not reduced to the condition of ghosts; when the vow of this Ekadashi is observed by them. This Ekadashi destroys the sin of the murder of a Brahmana and it also destroys the state of a goblin.

Amalaki Ekadashi (falls in the bright half of Phalguna): A man who goes to the root of Amalaki (Indian gooseberry tree), and keeps awake there during the night becomes free from all sins and obtains the fruit of giving away a thousand cows.

THE ART OF LEADING - A Healthy, Happy & Honourable Life

Destroyer of all diseases, the health-giving Sthalbasti or Ashvani Mudra

- * It cures 132 diseases.
- * Leucorrhoea, deficiency of dhatu, Nocturnal-Emission & abdominal disorders are removed.
- * Turns the flow of Kundalini-Shakti and Prana Shakti upwards.

Method: Lie down on a blanket in supine position facing the head towards east or south in morning. Exhale completely; and then contract anal sphincters 30-40 times just as a horse does while defecating. Repeat this process 4-5 times.

For Prosperity, Peace & Happiness

* Take bath after massaging the body with cow's-curd. * The wealth is obtained with self-effort and increase of religious merits; it increases with donation, virtuous deeds and skills; it stays or becomes stable with self-restraint and righteousness. But the wealth earned through committing sins, tormenting or terrorizing others gets destroyed within 10 years creating disputes, conflicts and fear. * Making the auspicious mark of 'Swastika' or 'Om' with the mixture of turmeric powder & rice or only turmeric powder on the outer surface of the door or wall of your house



helps in overcoming Vaastu defects. * Keeping 'Grihadosh-Nivarak' (Vaastu defect remover); made and freely given by Sant Shri Asharamji Ashrams; in every room of your house safeguards you against family strife, Vaastu defects, evil influence caused by dissatisfied Pitris, and the effects of evil eyes. If you keep it in your office; all your visitors will get pleased with you.

Health-giving bath and sun bath

* Taking bath with a paste prepared by mixing water with a mixture of flours of wheat, rice, barley, grams, green-grams, black-grams, and sesame seeds (in equal quantities) you get religious merits, cheerfulness, and health (It is available at Sant Shri Asharamji Ashrams & Sewa Samiti Centres). Take a bath on festivals by rubbing cow-urine on the body. It destroys sins.

* Sunbathing helps in almost every disease. It is health promoting. Sit in the sun every morning after covering your head with a cloth facing the sun for eight minutes; and by turning your back to the sun for 10 minutes. You shouldn't take sunbath longer than this; and the sunrays shouldn't be too hot.

How to get maximum nutrition from your food?

(1) Mentally offer your food to your Gurudev or your presiding deity before taking meal. Read 15th Chapter of Bhagavada Gita before taking food.

(2) Take lukewarm water while eating food.

(3) Stroll for some time after taking food; then lie down in supine position for 8 breaths, on your right side for 16 breaths; and on your left side for 32 breaths; but do not sleep – this facilitates the digestion of food.

(4) 'Harad-Rasayan Yoga' is the best combination that pacifies three *doshas* and cleanses the body. It cures 132 diseases. Suck two tablets in morning and evening.

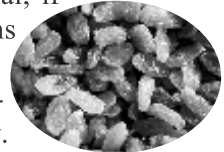
An effective herbal cure for Diabetes – tried successfully on many patients

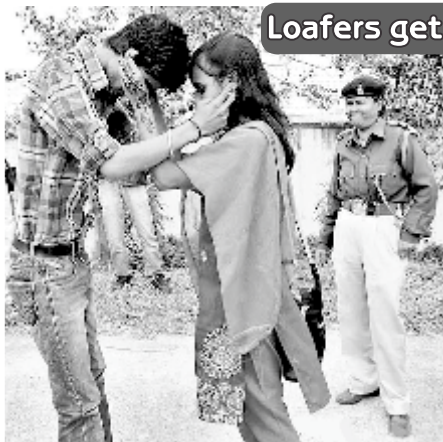
UNIVERSAL RESOLVE:
